

# I Love My Library Sticker Contest

## Official Terms and Conditions

### Deadline

**4/13/2026**

### Eligibility

- Everyone with a Delaware County Library Card is eligible.
- Entries will be separated into two groups by age, 5-13 and 13 and up.
- Children under 18 will have to have their entry form signed by a legal guardian.

### Originality

- Designs must be original and unpublished.
- A text slogan about the library is optional.
- Designs cannot include copyrighted, trademarked, or intellectual property.
- Designs may not include AI images either generated or modified.

### Content

- Designs cannot include profanity, trademarks, or other organization's logos.
- Entries with explicit content will not be considered for this contest.
- Designs will be resized to fit a 2.5-inch diameter circle sticker.
- Designs will be given a border including the Lansdowne Public Library Logo.
- Designs deemed low quality may be removed from consideration.

### Other contest rules

- The library reserves the right to modify the final design.
- Limit of 2 entries per Person.
- The winning designs will be used by the Lansdowne Public Library on stickers and library marketing and may be used in other capacities.

## Rights

- Copyright in any images submitted to the competition remains with the respective Entrants.
- By submitting a Sticker Design to the Lansdowne Public Library, you hereby provide an irrevocable and perpetual license to The Lansdowne Public Library and The Friends of The Lansdowne Public Library to use, copy, reproduce, alter, distribute, and display or publish your Sticker Design in any and all media now known or hereafter devised without any additional compensation.
- The Lansdowne Public Library reserves the right to use any Contest participant's Sticker Design, in whole or in part, including any modifications or amendments thereto.
- Submission of a Sticker Design in the Contest does not obligate The Lansdowne Public Library to use such Sticker Design.

## What to enter

- Submissions may be created using graphic design software but cannot include AI generated art.
- Submissions may also be hand-drawn using markers, pencils, pens, markers, paint, or other mixed media tools.
- Designs must fit inside a circle.
- Digital files should be at a 300 DPI resolution and sent as a PNG or JPG.

## How to enter

- Physical entry forms may be turned in at the Lansdowne Public Library front desk.

- Late or incomplete entries will not be considered.

## Judging

- There will be 4 winners total, 2 from each age category.
- The first winner from each category will be selected by an online popular vote.
- An additional winner from each category will be chosen by library staff.

**Winners will be announced no later than April 24th, 2026. All judging decisions are final.**
